Why We Don't Council Together Regularly

- Counter culture and awkward

- Ineffective because parents don't facilitate a successful process
- Parents not on the same page

Elements of Effective Councils

- Meet first as executive council (Note for those who are divorced)
- Give notice on the topic
- Eliminate distractions
- Someone leads out in the discussion
- Create an atmosphere of love and safety
- Share goal or purpose of council
- Use Solution Focused thinking



Leader Facilitates to Ensure

- Keep the council focused on just one topic
- All members are heard
- Good listening and responsible speaking happens
- Curiosity and interest expressed in each person's perspective
- Summarize what has been discussed
- Come to a consensus as much as possible
- Plan, Do, Review
- Meet regularly
