Honest Differences



Reasons Teens Manipulate

- To Get Their Way
- For Love and Affection
- To Cover Their Rear
- To Punish One Parent
- To Feel Powerful
- Because it Works



Ways Teens Split Parents

- Join one parent against the other "You know how Dad is" (triangulation)
- Go to one and not both parents to ask for something
- Tell half truths of what one parent said or agreed to
- Ask for something when only one parent is available
- Wait until there is a time crunch to ask for an immediate decision



How Parents Undermine Each Other

- Throw one parent under the bus "I would let you, but Mom doesn't think you should"
- Criticizing other parent to the child
- Reversal of one parent's decision
- Being a proponent of the child's point of view in front of the child
- A host of non-verbals (rolling eyes, body language sending clear message they don't agree)
- Using language like "Figures...", "Par for the course around here"
